Protect current retirees, create personal retirement accounts, reform incentives, and ensure long-term sustainability.

8. Secure the Border and Reform Immigration

Finish the wall, end catch and release, enforce asylum law, mandate E-Verify, and move to a merit-based system.

9. Energy Independence and Rare Earth Revival

Expand domestic energy production, modernize the grid, streamline permitting, and exploit critical minerals at home.

10. Election Integrity and Term Limits

Clean voter rolls, voter ID, paper ballots, end ballot harvesting, and restore a citizen legislature through term limits.
